FACT SHEET: SCREENING TREES

Prunus laurocerasus Novita (Cherry Laurel)

Due to its dense, dark leaves Prunus laurocerasus Novita is commonly planted for screening, however it can also be used as a stand-alone tree, growing with an upright, broad habit.

Cherry laurel (also known as English Laurel) has fresh green leaves on foliage, which get darker and glossier with age. In May, mature trees produce a display of white blossom, which grow on upright racemes.

NB Prunus laurocerasus Novita can produce black, conical fruit, however these are poisonous, so be cautious when planting near livestock or children.

Ideal Conditions: Grows well in most soil
